Holydays of Obligation

The Bishops' Conference of England and Wales has agreed the following changes to take effect from 1st Sunday of Advent 2017:

- Epiphany of the Lord to celebrated on 6 January, except when this falls on a Saturday or a Monday when it is transferred to the adjacent Sunday.
- **Ascension of the Lord** to be celebrated on Thursday in the 6th Week of Easter.
