Liturgy News

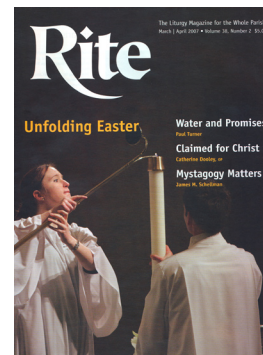
